

Dance Attire

The dress code should be strictly adhered to. A well-dressed student creates a focused, professional, and safe environment for your child and others. The dress code also ensures that each dancer is properly dressed to train their body. Extra layers and other items not included in the dress code will interfere with the eye's ability to identify correct lines of the body. Please refrain from wearing jewelry, costume tutus, shorts, sweatpants, or t-shirts. Official dress code is as follows:

Hair MUST be pulled back into a bun for Tech I levels and higher. Hair pulled back and out of the face for Pre-Technique classes is acceptable and highly encouraged.

Recreational Levels:

Pre-Tech I:	Leotard of any style or color, <i>optional</i> short one-layer chiffon dance skirt, pink tights, pink ballet shoes
Pre-Tech II & Tech I:	Leotard of any style or color, <i>optional</i> short one-layer chiffon dance skirt, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, tan tap shoes
Tech II:	Leotard of any style or color, <i>optional</i> short one-layer chiffon dance skirt, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, tan tap shoes, tan jazz shoes (no laces)

Academy Levels:

Ballet/Pointe:	Leotard of any color and style, <i>optional</i> short one-layer chiffon dance skirt, tights of any color, pink ballet shoes; no shorts of any style or extra layers
Jazz and/or Tap:	Leotard or crop top of any color and style, tights of any color, and tan jazz shoes for levels I and II, turners for levels III and IV or black tap shoes for all levels; <i>optional</i> spandex shorts or leggings
Modern:	Tights and a leotard of any color or style, no shoes
